## **James Bond Martini Cocktails**

## 'The Vesper'

Gin, vodka, sweet vermouth, with a twisted lemon peel
The Vesper was invented and named by 007. He named the martini
after the lead female in 'Casino Royale', Vesper Lynd. In 'Casino
Royale' she is assigned the task of working alongside Bond to assist
him in his mission to bankrupt Le Chiffre. Vesper is killed during this
mission and in 'Quantum of Solace', Bond seeks revenge for her
death.

## 'The Skyfall'

Vodka, crème de cassis, topped with Bollinger champagne 007 will always be known for his martini preference. In Skyfall, Bond's loyalty to M is tested as her past comes to haunt her. As M16 comes under attack 007 must track down and destroy the threat, at much personal cost. Although Skyfall begins with Bond missing and presumed dead, we have no doubt that 007 is sipping on a vodka martini...shaken and not stirred.







## 'Goldfinger'

Vodka, dry vermouth, olives

Auric Goldfinger is the main villain in the 1964 James Bond film 'Goldfinger'. Goldfinger was voted the most sinister James Bond villain of all time. His encounter with 007 has made the quote 'Mr Bond I expect you to die' part of James Bond history. This dirty martini is perfect for our dirty gold smuggling thief.

## 'Miss Moneypenny'

Vodka, cointreau, midori with a glace cherry

Moneypenny is the private secretary to M, head of the British
Intelligence, the MI6. Miss Moneypenny has never been
romantically involved with Bond but she has helped the secret agent
to hide his love affairs with other women. This Japanese Slipper
Martini is a tribute to the loyal, clever and intelligent secretary.

#### 'Felix Leiter'

Gin, Lemon juice, cointreau, marmalade
Bond becomes good friends with Leiter, an American CIA agent in a
way which he does not with any other character. Leiter is left
helpless after he losses an arm and a leg in a shark attack. Bond is
then forced to avenge an attack on Leiter's wife in the film Licence to
Kill. This breakfast martini is a salute to Bond and Leiter's friendship.
